

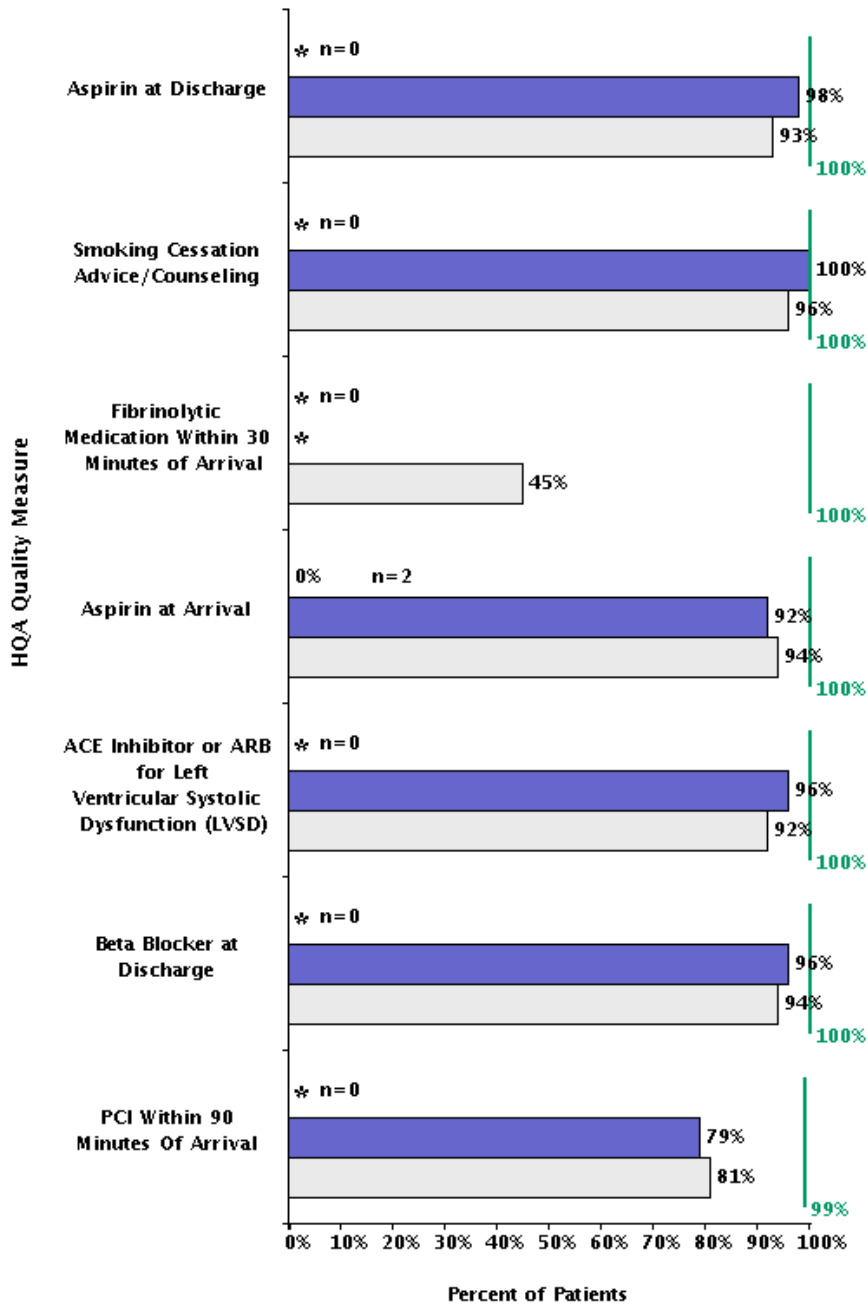

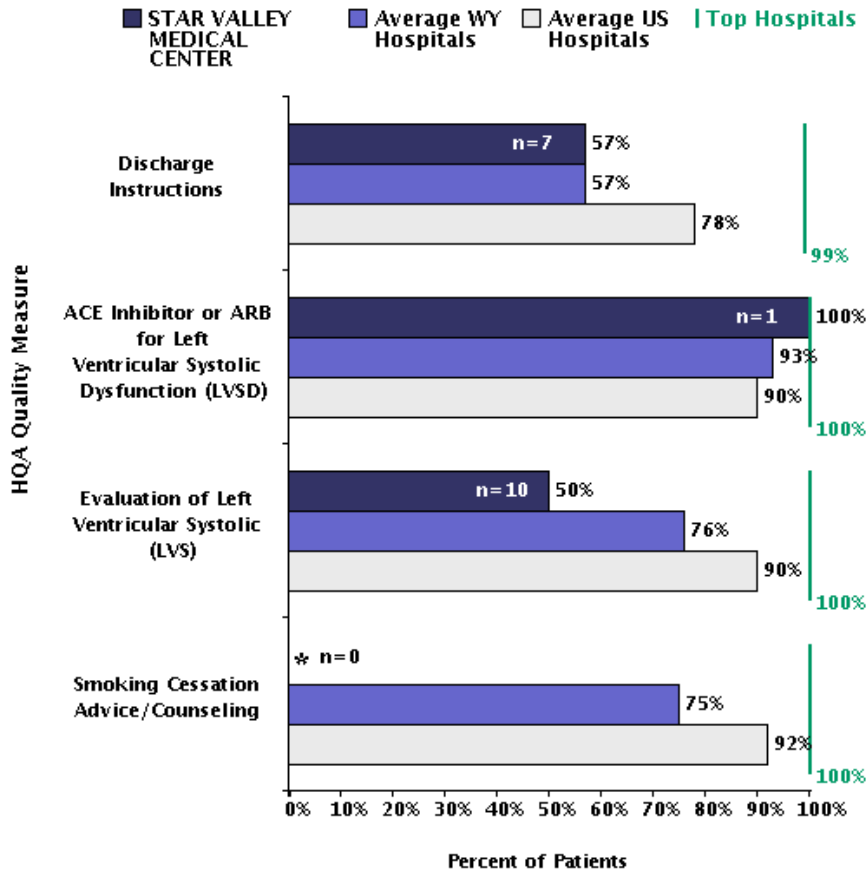

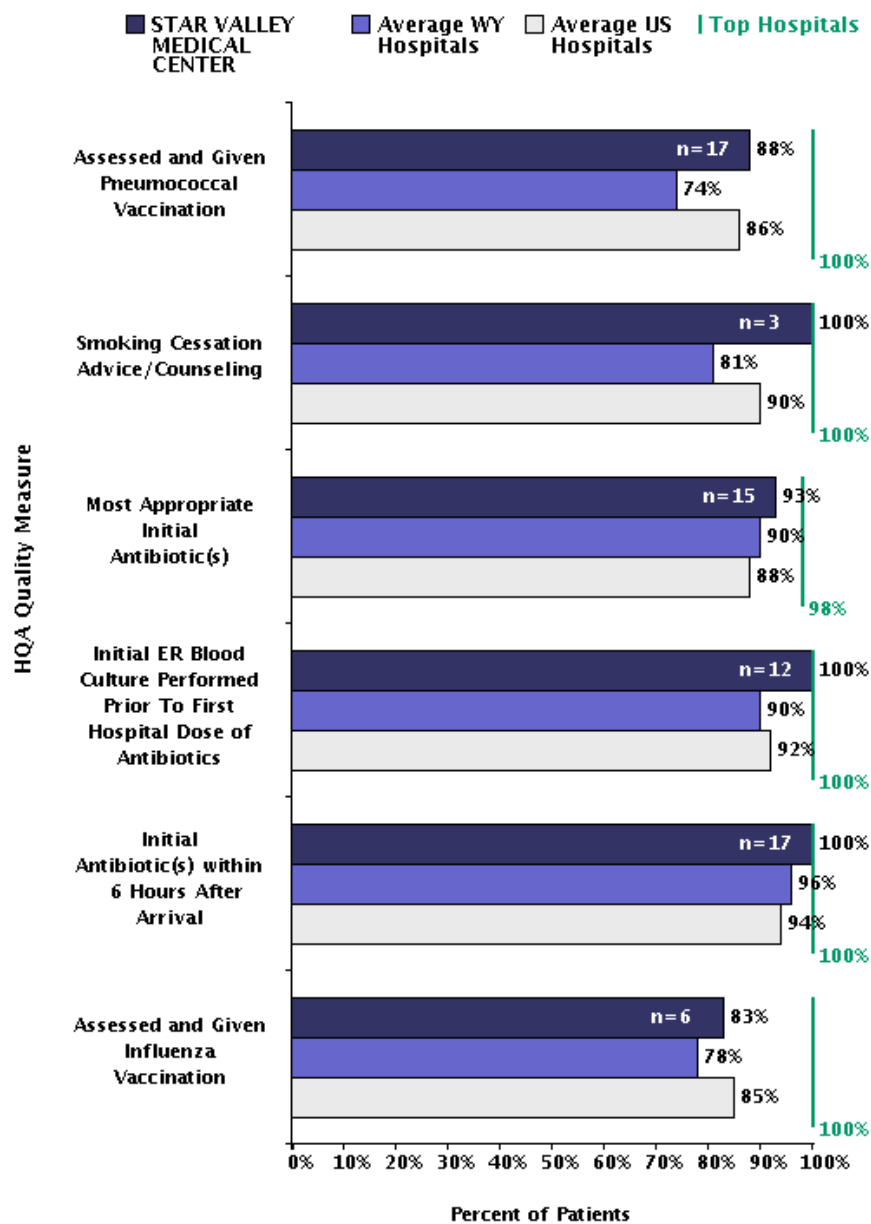

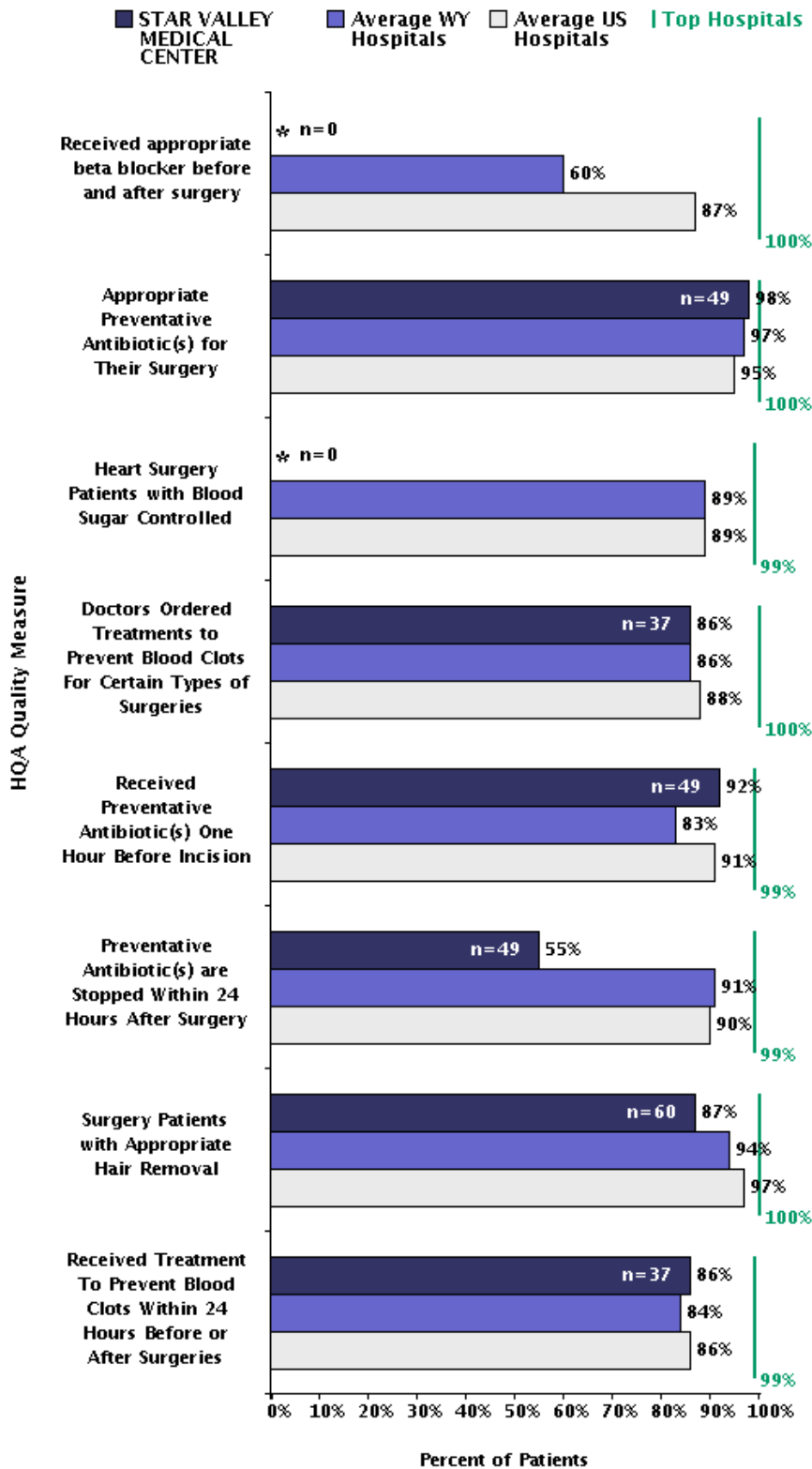
### Heart Failure Measures

Also, as of the September 13, 2007 report, Patients Given PCI Within 120 Minutes of Arrival was changed to Within 90 Minutes of Arrival.
